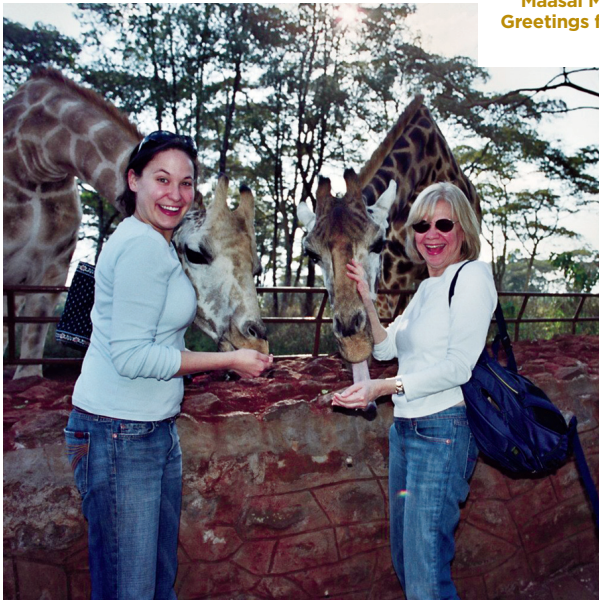


Game Night

Giraffes in Nairobi
