Castles, Gardens and Canals

Wander the gloomy tunnels beneath Kronborg Castle — better known as Hamlet’s Elsinore. Take in the amusements of Tivoli Gardens and glide past sites both grand and quaint on a canal tour, from the Rococo-style Prince’s Mansion to the houseboats of beautiful Christianshavn. At the Royal Palace of Amalienborg, catch the festive changing of the guards.

Faroes Islands and Scandinavian Metropolises

Have a cup of coffee with a 17th-generation farmer at Kirkjubøargarður, a grass-roofed home on Denmark’s Faroe Islands. Spend three days in this remote land, where Viking settlements and puffin colonies meet on verdant, sheep-studded cliffs and fiber arts flourish in the colorful capital of Torshavn. This 11-day tour divides its time between the islands, Copenhagen, and Bergen, Norway, painting a lovely portrait of cool Scandinavia.

Viking Ship Ride, and Modern Art

Row the waters of Roskilde Fjord on a traditional wooden vessel at the Viking Ship Museum on a private tour of Copenhagen and beyond. The whole family will appreciate the Louisiana Museum of Modern Art, a stunning countryside complex of Danish modernist structures with some 3,500 works and its own wing for kids.
