## Caribbean Gems by Yacht

Hike to an abandoned lighthouse in Culebrita for sweeping views of this Puerto Rican wildlife refuge. The uninhabited island is one stop on a five-day yachting adventure that docks at distinctive ports, including Saba in the Netherlands Antilles and Gustavia, St. Bart's boutique-packed capital. On Jost Van Dyke, sip champagne in the surf before your beach barbecue.

## Real Jamaica

Take a drumming lesson in an indigenous Rastafarian village — the perfect kickoff to a ten-day Jamaican adventure.

Visit little-known beaches, drink a Red Stripe on a sand bar and tour the Blue Mountain coffee plantation. Visit the Bob Marley museum and have a feast and dance party at a village of Maroon people, descendants of escaped slaves who established refugee communities.

## Bermuda by Bike

Cycle along rocky coastlines and magnificent lookout points on Bermuda's Railway Trail, winding around nearly the whole island. This four-day escape is ideal for families, with plenty of playtime on pink-sand beaches, swimming with dolphins and exploring the cool Crystal Caves.
