Archaeological Dig

On a full-day tour that has you in the ground alongside experts from the University of Athens, you'll learn the basics of excavating priceless ancient sites and perhaps make some historical findings of your own. This quiet town is the site of the Battle of Marathon, when Greek forces defeated Persian invaders, and a burial mound is still visible nearby.
